Ted Gale Award Winners

This award is made by the Chairman and President to a member of the Harrow Referees' Association who has made a significant contribution to the society. By tradition a member only receives it once. It is not awarded every year.

Ted Gale was Secretary of Harrow Society from 1957-66 and then Chairman from 1967-76. He later became President from 1980 until his death in 1982. He was known for his robust and challenging speeches at the annual RA conference, never being afraid to hold authority to account in his quest to advance the cause of refereeing.

Chris Forsdike Award Winners

The shield and memento are presented annually to the **Young Referee of the Year** for their contribution to football refereeing and Harrow RA throughout the season. To be eligible the member must be 25 or under at the start of the season.

The award is made in memory of Chris Forsdike, a founder member of Harrow Referees' Society who was its secretary from 1936-1957. He presented a cheque to HRS with the request that it be used to reward up and coming members. It was first awarded in 1992 when the winner was Tony Basham (the only person to win it in consecutive seasons). Tony has lived in Denmark for many years but continued to be a member of Harrow until recently.

Chris retired to Lymington in Hampshire but stayed in touch with the society until he passed away.
